- Pledge Day will be held 11/5 orchestra students have new sweatshirts for the event.

- On 11/15 SHS Music Masters will be held in the orchestra room beginning at about 3:15. Students from band, orchestra and chorus will perform. The event will last approximately an hour.
- On 11/19 the Lyrica performance (cello and piano) will be held at Chatham Presbyterian Church at 3 pm.
- Rotary performance for chamber orchestra and chamber choir will be held in December, either on 11/11 or 11/18.

- On 2/9/18 the Wind Ensemble will be performing at Montclair State jointly with the MSU wind ensemble. We are already looking at music for that performance.

Treasurer Report – Stacey Supran

- SMPA's biggest fundraisers are Pledge Day and football concessions. Volunteers are needed for both.
- 25% of membership dues are in. Not a lot of budgeted funds have been spent yet but it is early in the year.
- Friday Night Lights revenues were down from last year.
- We are looking for a shadow treasurer who will take over next year (succession planning).

- Notifications were sent out regarding trip scholarships. Twelve scholarships were extended. SMPA is considering one late request. No student received 100% of the cost of the trip as a scholarship.
- Parent chaperone needs have been filled.

Concessions – Francie Cho

- Overall concessions revenues are down this year. In particular, the 9/29 Friday 4 PM was not well attended.
- We are short on volunteers. As a reminder, SMPA concessions funds benefits band, orchestra and chorus students. All parents should volunteer for at least one shift.
- Gross receipts so far are \$7,871 and net receipts approximately \$5,200.

- It was noted that students who participate in Pledge Day receive trip credits of \$50 for each year in which they participate.
